

Submission instructions

1. Get a github account, if you don't have one
2. You receive from us a link to the github page of the assignment.
3. On github, you accept the invitation. For the very first time (A2), you should form teams.
4. For subsequent assignments, use the existing team names (do not form a new team for every assignment).
5. A repository is automatically created for the team, possibly with starter code for the assignment
6. Each team member clones the repository on his/her local machine.
7. The assignment is done collaboratively by the team members using git.
8. The final version of your software should be committed and pushed to the remote before the deadline. Any commit after the deadline will be ignored.

Teams and packaging

- Team naming
 - for 2-member team: Surname1_Surname2
 - for 1-member team: Surname
- Place all you classes in **one single package** that has **the same name as the team**
- Make sure that **only one class** implements the interface provided in the starter code, and the class has a **default constructor**
- Not following the above rules may hinder the checking of your assignment and may lead to a lower grade!
